- Actions: ► to develop ports in the Danube river basin into multimodal logistics centres
  - ► to promote sustainable freight transport in the Danube Region
- **Key Tasks:** ► draft coordinated and harmonised development concept for multimodal ports; involve Danube countries and relevant stakeholders; elaborate or review national port development plans for integration into local and regional development strategies establish intermodal interfaces (ports) especially between inland navigation and railway freight transport, thus helping increase multimodal freight transport
- Targets: ➤ develop efficient multimodal terminals at river ports along the Danube and its navigable tributaries to connect inland waterways with rail and road transport by 2020
  - ▶ increase the cargo transport on the river by 20% by 2020 compared to 2010
