




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Meeting Minutes for 2nd SG session






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Identification of PA 1a projects \rightarrow data sheet

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Preparation of EUSDR "flagship project": **Innovative Danube Vessel**

- Study commissioned by PAC 1a (via donau) on behalf of DG REGIO
- Overall objective: **Elaboration** and **development** of innovative vessel and technology solutions with high potential for implementation on the Danube
- Analysis of **solutions** derived **from existing R&D** projects with respect to their potential for implementation and further development in the Danube region
- **Provision** of **recommendations** for further technology development within the framework of the Danube Region Strategy
- Project duration: 18 months (until end of 2013)


















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Support of EC ad hoc initiative on improvement of Danube waterway infrastructure maintenance

- High-Level meeting EC Danube Region countries on 7-8 June on the occasion of the Transport Council









Criteria for Project Labelling

The criteria specified below shall be the basis to evaluate project proposals which have been submitted by means of a Project Data Sheet (cf. Addendum B) to the Coordinators of PA 1a of the European Union Strategy for the Danube Region (EUSDR)

Having regard to the provisions concerning the factors to be considered for identifying EUSDR actions and projects as stipulated in the

- Communication from the European Commission on the European Union Strategy for the Danube Region and the
- · Action Plan accompanying the Communication on the European Union Strategy for the Danube Region²

the Steering Group for Priority Area 1a will decide if the project under consideration will contribute to the implementation of Priority Area 1a of the EUSDR and shall thus receive a

Criteria for labelling a project and to issue a Letter of Recommendation

- The project complies with any of the targets and/or the corresponding actions established for Priority Area to of the Danube Region Strategy (cf. Addendum A) and demonstrates added value for this Priority Area.
- 2. The project has an impact on the macro-region or a significant part of it, which can derive from regional and local activities as well.
- In the Danube region
- 4. A proposal for the project must be ready for submission or must have been submitted to a specific call of a relevant funding scheme (reference to the

munication from the Commission to the European Parliament, the Council, the European Economic and Social ittee and the Committee of the Regions: European Union Strategy for the Danube Region, COM(2010) 715 final mission Staff Working Document: Action Plan Accompanying document to the Communication from the Commission to opean Parlament, the Council, the European Economic and Social Committee and the Committee of the Regions: an Union Strategy for the Danable Region, SEC(2010) 1480 final .

→ Establishment of criteria for "project labelling"









Setting for "project labelling"

- 1. The criteria shall be the basis to evaluate project proposals – i.e., projects in preparation phase
- 2. The criteria are derived from:
 - **Communication from the European Commission on the EUSDR**
 - Action Plan accompanying the Communication from the EC on the EUSDR
- 3. The Steering Group will decide if the project complies with the criteria and shall thus receive a Letter of Recommendation







Criteria for "project labelling"

- 1. The project <u>complies with any of the targets and/or the</u>
 <u>corresponding actions</u> of PA1a and demonstrates added value
 for this PA.
- 2. The project has an <u>impact on the macro-region or a significant</u> part of it, which can derive from regional and local activities as well.
- 3. The major part of the project, its activities or its related impacts are <u>located in the Danube region</u>.
- 4. A <u>proposal</u> for the project must be <u>ready for submission or</u> <u>must have been submitted</u> to a specific funding call (reference in Letter of Recommendation).








ROAD MAP = strategic concept

- How? Coordinators of PAC 1a together with involved actors will have to undertake recurrent (1) and specific (2) activities



regular updates









ROAD MAP describes

- the timeframe of implementation
- tasks (sub-activities)
- the expected output / results
